


DISCIPLESHIP WIN TEAM MEETING NOTES – AUGUST 19, 2018

- This illustration provides clarity as to what the bridges and pathways part of our goal is really about. While we want to bring new people in the doors, our foremost priority is to help move current MUMC churchgoers from worship to connect, worship to serve, connect to serve and/or serve to connect.
- We reviewed the pilot program (launching in Sept) and in an effort to better incorporate missions (serve) in the program, we have added the following ministries to the program – Bike Rehab, Fair Trade and Food 4 Kids. - We discussed the idea of adding one or two yes/no questions to the online registration process for small groups, classes, ministries, etc to help us better identify new participants. Something as simple as “Is this your first time attending a small group/class, etc at MUMC?” We hope this will serve as a quick and easy way to help our tracking process. **Tiffany is working on this task.**
- We revisited the plan to get testimonials from current ministry participants/leaders to capture the qualitative info that not only complements our data tracking but also can/should be used as additional promotion/marketing. This might be in form of videos displayed in the Narthex or during worship or even just simple anonymous quotes that can be shared on the website, Facebook, etc. Regarding video testimonials (talking heads), we need to discuss further with church leadership to determine our options and timeline for such. **Jeff will be looking into this.**
- We came up with a plan to use 2018 new members as a test/focus group to follow and help through their discipleship path at MUMC. With their permission, we would like to get to know them better and by doing so offer them more specific guidance for getting plugged in. The process is unclear yet. Might be something as simple as a questionnaire via email or might be phone call or personal meeting at some point. We will have firm # on size of the group after the Sept new members class. **Tiffany and Jim Clark are helping to get this info.**
- The topic of ministry fairs came up. We agreed they are successful and we would like to plan more, and possibly connect with worship somehow. Looking at 2019 timeline.
