

MO-Hab Bike Ride XXII: June 4 - 9, 2019

Registration Due by March 31, 2019 Register early! - The ride is limited to 40 participants.

Purpose of Ride - To raise awareness and funds for Habitat for Humanity St. Louis®. Thanks to the generous financial support and hard work of volunteers, Habitat for Humanity St. Louis recognizes Manchester UMC as a Keystone Community Partner. Over the 22 years of partnership, MUMC has contributed to and worked on many of the 400 Habitat for Humanity homes built in St. Louis City and County. Illinois Route 66 - 250 miles (+)

Tues June 4: Meet at church and travel to Pontiac, IL

Wed June 5: Pontiac to Normal, IL - 49 mi.

Thurs June 6: Normal to Lincoln, IL - 53 mi.

Fri June 7: Lincoln to Springfield, IL - 42 mi.

Sat June 8: Springfield to Litchfield, IL - 51 mi.

Sun June 9: Litchfield to St. Louis, MO - 55 mi.

Lodging is in motels each night. The rates range from \$50 to \$85 per room and include a continental breakfast. Some motels have swimming pools, others may have laundry facilities. Lodging is paid in advance. Money will be collected at the Rider Meeting on April 22. We reserve the rooms for riders and staff when we receive registrations.

Meals - Breakfast is provided at the Hotels. Lunch is in one of the towns along the route. Some days have more than one option. Dinner is in the overnight town at a local café or restaurant. Most evenings there are different options for dinner. We will eat together on the final evening.

Transportation, Gear shuttle and SAG support are a shared responsibility of the group. A registration fee of \$60 per person is used to cover expenses such as gas, snacks, ice, sports drinks, your t-shirt, and other incidentals. Dedicated SAG volunteers and help from the pool of riders are needed to support the group. Transportation of bikes and riders to the ride start in Pontiac, IL is included in the registration fee.

Rider Meeting - SAVE THE DATE! The meeting will be held at Manchester United Methodist Church in Room 141 on **April 22**, at 7 p.m. Final details of the ride will be discussed, hotel fee collected, meal reservations/ choices discussed. *Your attendance is important!*

Training - Ride as many miles as possible and as often as possible before the start of MO-Hab XXII; striving to log as many training miles as you will ride during the week long journey across Illinois. (approximately 250) **We strongly recommend you participate in as many group training rides as possible.** See the 2019 Training Ride Schedule. Helmets - All riders are required to wear a helmet that meets or exceeds ANSI or Snell standards.
