 - 2. Allows specifics so all people know they belong
- II. Journeys/What We Can Do
 - A. How Can We Help People Belong
 - 1. Don't just tolerate, be proactive in encouraging all walks of life
 - 2. Don't close the door if people are on their journey
 - 3. Understand that we won't always be the church for everyone
 - 4. Have people willing to participate in a journey
 - 5. Engage in relationships with others
 - 6. Create an appropriate culture
 - B. The Faith Journey
 - 1. Everyone is on a journey, but not everyone is in the same place
 - 2. How do we recognize where people are on their journey?
 - 3. Journeys will be at different speeds and on different paths
 - C. Questions to Ask Ourselves
 - 1. How can we get to the point where everyone agrees that everyone is welcome?
 - 2. How can we do something that does no harm?
 - 3. How do we make all people feel welcome with no harm?
 - D. What We Need to Know
 - Some people in this church are saying that they feel rejected and unwelcomed since they respect the welcome statement, but feel too forced to fully endorse it

- 2. Grace needs to be on both ends (our end and the entire congregation/new members)
- 3. Conversations can/will be difficult to have

- 1. Pairing with someone close to your thought level (NOT an extremist and an unaccepting)
- 2. Courageous Conversations (Corporate curriculum focused around lived experience)

IV. Who Are The People of Our Community

- A. Viewed Mission Insite Report (Executive report on demographics from the church address and out 10 miles)
 - 1. Population- Steady in # of population, families, and households (Gone up a tad)
 - 2. Racial and Ethnic Trends- White predominant by far, 85% white, runner up is Asian with 6%, will remain that way.
 - 2a. If the area isn't very racially diverse, we cannot expect the church to be
 - 3. Age Trends-Median age is 43
 - 3a. What is the church's population age trend? Age demographics of new members? How to retain members through all age levels
 - 3b. One size does not fit all
 - 3c. What We Can Do- Rethink how we worship, embrace technology
 - 4. School-Aged Children Trends- Pretty Stable
 - 5. Income Trends- \$130K average, 13% increase by 2026 (AA-\$61K, White-\$94K)
 - 6. Household Trends- Households with children (81% married, 19% single)
 - 7. Marital Trends- 1 in 5 are single
 - 8. Adult Education Attainment-Highly educated population (56% BA or higher in our radius vs. 29% BA or higher in all of Missouri
 - 9. Population by Employment- 80% are white-collar, 20% are blue-collar
 - 10. Generational Trends- 29% Millennial (Y), 27% Gen X, 20% Boom, 18% Homeland (Z)
 - 10a. Gen Z is our future, children of Gen Xers, who we need to prepare for
