How to track people who took survey first time versus second time – can utilize system that can track duplicate names across survey administration – determine consistent responders

Consider type-face readability for seniors/visual impairment

Discussion of ranges of years attended and how be clear - what info trying to gather - can we cross reference that longer attending members know the history versus new people learning as newer members

Be careful which software use that has capability to do cross-reference of results
